**2012 - 2013 Academic Scholarships/Awards**

**Boarding Students**

**Chancellor Frederick W. Hill Scholarship (15 awards) \$ 3,000**

- Awarded in June 2012
- Open to boarding students
- 5 awards per grade given to the top academic students entering Grade 10 or 11 based on Math, English, Science and 1 Social Science (minimum 80% GPA)
- 5 awards given to the top academic students entering Grade 12 based on Math, English, top two Natural Sciences and 1 Social Science (minimum of 80% GPA)
- Mother Edith Scholarship or Don Geesen-Mosaic Potash, Belle Plain Scholarship winners are ineligible

**Don Geesen-Mosaic Potash, Belle Plain Scholarship (1 award) \$ 5,000**

- Awarded in June 2012
- Open to boarding students registering for Grade 12
- Preference will be given to a Saskatchewan student from a farming background
- Student must excel in Science (Chemistry and at least one of the remaining three Sciences)
- Student must be on the Honor Roll
- Chancellor Frederick W. Hill Scholarship or Mother Edith Scholarship winners are ineligible

**International Student Achievement Scholarships (3 awards) \$ 3,000**

- Awarded in June 2012
- Open to students paying international fees
- 2 awards given to the top academic students entering Grade 11 or Grade 12 based on Math, English, Science and 1 Social Science (minimum of 80% GPA)
- 1 award given to a top academic student who is or has taken at least one EAL (English as a Second Language) class at the College. The award will be based on Math, English, Science and 1 Social Science (minimum of 80% GPA)

**Mother Edith Scholarship (2 awards) \$ 9,875**

- Awarded in June 2012
- Open to returning Grade 12, 7 day boarding students taking a full Grade 11 course load
- Two students with the highest GPA based on top 8 core subjects

**Local/Day Students**

**President's Achievement Award (9 awards) No Monetary Value**

- Awarded in June 2012
- Open to local/day students
- 3 awards per grade given to the top academic students entering Grade 10 or 11 based on Math, English, Science and 1 Social Science (minimum 80% GPA)
- 3 awards given to the top academic student entering Grade 12 based on Math, English and top two Natural Sciences and 1 Social Science (minimum of 80% GPA)
